IMPORTANT INFORMATION - CHANGES TO DATA PROTECTION

From 25 May this year new rules regarding General Data Protection come into force.

There are new rights for people to access the information companies hold about them, as well as obligations for better data management for businesses, charities and public sector organisations. The new rules mean that consent to retain and process data and information requires specific affirmative action. Where data is processed for more than one purpose consent needs to be obtained for each purpose.

What this means for Social Club Members:

For Social Club Members this means that consent is required for specific activities, such as our emergency contact process and receiving newsletters. Before we take any photographs, we will also ask you to sign a form to give us consent to publish and use any photographs.

If you are receiving this newsletter as a social club member then you will also have received a Consent Letter to complete and post back to us in a stamped addressed envelope. Your consent letter will be retained by FDM whilst you continue to be a member.

Once we receive your consent form we will then also write separately to any named emergency contact to also seek their permission to retain and use their details only in the case of an emergency.

If we do not receive a completed consent letter by 25 May, then FDM will not be able to issue you a Newsletter and Program of upcoming trips. If you have any difficulties completing the consent letter, please contact Katy on Wednesday between 10am and 12 noon or between 2pm and 4pm, or on Thursday between 2pm and 4 pm.

What this means for User Groups:

Over the next couple of weeks we will contact each of our registered user groups to discuss and obtain the relevant consent that relates to the particular organisation.
